

# House Bill 2530

Sponsored by Representative REARDON (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

Prescribes requirements for guidance counselors in schools.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to guidance counselors.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Each school district shall ensure that students of the school district have**  
5 **access to qualified guidance counselors who are:**

6 (1) **Licensed by the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission as a school counselor;**

7 **or**

8 (2) **Qualified to be a licensed school counselor through education or experience and who**  
9 **have received professional development on the delivery of comprehensive school counseling**  
10 **services in accordance with rules adopted by the State Board of Education.**
