

House Bill 2801

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Justice to conduct study on availability of appellate review of judgments denying post-conviction relief and to present report on findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary on or before September 15, 2018.

Sunsets January 2, 2019.

2 Relating to post-conviction relief.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of Justice shall conduct a study on the availability of ap-**
5 **pellate review of judgments denying post-conviction relief and present any recommended**
6 **legislative changes, in a report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related**
7 **to the judiciary, in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 on or before September 15, 2018.**

8 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2, 2019.**
