

# House Bill 2936

Sponsored by Representative EVANS

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Consumer and Business Services to study how Occupational Safety and Health Division enforces state rules.  
Sunsets January 2, 2022.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to Occupational Safety and Health Division.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Consumer and Business Services shall conduct a**  
5 **study to examine how the Occupational Safety and Health Division enforces state workplace**  
6 **safety and health rules and shall make a report on its findings.**

7 **(2) The department shall submit the report required by subsection (1) of this section, and**  
8 **may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative**  
9 **Assembly related to business and labor in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 no later**  
10 **than September 15, 2021.**

11 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2019 Act is repealed on January 2, 2022.**
