## House Bill 2936

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Presession filed (at the request of Governor Tina Kotek for Oregon Health Authority)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Tells OHA to study if the health insurance market is cost effective. (Flesch Readability Score: 60.7).

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to study marketplace affordability. Directs the authority to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health care not later than September 15, 2026.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to marketplace affordability.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
  - <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Oregon Health Authority shall study marketplace affordability. The authority shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health care no later than September 15, 2026.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.

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
