House Bill 3053

Sponsored by Representative NERON (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives money to HECC for a pilot program at UO for certain students training to work with kids who have certain needs. The Act declares an emergency. The Act becomes law on July 1, 2025. (Flesch Readability Score: 70.8).

Provides moneys to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to be distributed to the University of Oregon for purposes of a pilot program training graduate-level students who are learning to become speech-language pathologists to use a family-centered approach when serving children with augmentative and alternative communication needs in a traditional overnight summer camp setting.

Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- Relating to summer camp training for certain University of Oregon students; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to be distributed to the University of Oregon, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$40,000 for purposes of a pilot program at the University of Oregon to train graduate-level student clinicians who are studying to become speech-language pathologists to use a family-centered approach when serving children with augmentative and alternative communication needs in a traditional overnight summer camp setting.
 - SECTION 2. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect July 1, 2025.
