

House Bill 3135

Sponsored by Representative MARSH; Representatives FINDLEY, MITCHELL, Senator KNOPP

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Revenue, for purpose of enforcing state and local transient lodging taxes, to purchase software that scrapes online data relating to transient lodging rentals. Appropriates moneys to department for such purpose and related procurement costs.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to an appropriation to assist the Department of Revenue with the enforcement of transient
3 lodging taxes; and prescribing an effective date.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. For the purpose of enforcing state and local transient lodging taxes, the**
6 **Department of Revenue shall purchase software that scrapes online data relating to tran-**
7 **sient lodging rentals. The department shall make the software accessible to units of local**
8 **government that impose local transient lodging taxes.**

9 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2019 Act is repealed on January 2, 2023.**

10 **SECTION 3. There is appropriated to the Department of Revenue, for the biennium be-**
11 **ginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$_____ to enable the depart-**
12 **ment to carry out the purpose described in section 1 of this 2019 Act for the period beginning**
13 **on the effective date of this 2019 Act and ending on December 31, 2021, and to reimburse the**
14 **department for procurement costs related to that purpose.**

15 **SECTION 4. This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2019**
16 **regular session of the Eightieth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
