SUMMARY

It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives money to the OHA to test newborns for five specific diseases. (Flesch Readability Score: 65.7).

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Oregon Health Authority for the purpose of screening newborns for five specific diseases under the Northwest Regional Newborn Bloodspot Screening Program.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-

5 ated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2025, out of the

6 General Fund, the amount of \$4,000,000, for the purpose of screening newborns under the

7 Northwest Regional Newborn Bloodspot Screening Program for:

8 (1) Mucopolysaccharidosis type II (MPS II).

9 (2) Guanidinoacetate methyltransferase deficiency (GAMT).

10 (3) Krabbe disease.

- 12 (5) Cytomegalovirus.
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
