House Bill 3220

Sponsored by Representative NATHANSON, Senator PROZANSKI (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells the OSBN to make a rule about the ratio of students to faculty in some parts of nursing education programs. (Flesch Readability Score: 62.1).

Directs the Oregon State Board of Nursing to adopt rules to require a certain student-to-faculty

ratio in the clinical component of nursing education programs.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 678.010 to
5	678.410.
6	SECTION 2. (1) The Oregon State Board of Nursing shall adopt rules to require a
7	student-to-faculty ratio of at least 10 students to one faculty member in the clinical compo-
8	nents of nursing education programs. The board may adopt rules to allow a ratio of up to
9	15 students to one faculty member in circumstances determined by the board.
10	(2) The ratios described in subsection (1) of this section do not apply to simulation ex-
11	periences in nursing education programs.
12	SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2025 Act applies a nursing education program's clinical
13	component beginning on or after January 1, 2026.
