House Bill 3308

Sponsored by Representative EVANS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act says that certain government facilities must keep a three-week fuel supply. The Act also says that governments must use renewable diesel fuel. (Flesch Readability Score: 62.1).

Requires certain strategically important state and local government facilities to maintain a three-week fuel supply beginning in 2031. Requires all state and local government facilities to use renewable diesel for all diesel fuel requirements beginning in 2028.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to fuel.

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3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Oregon Department of Emergency Management shall identify facili-

5 ties owned or operated by the state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, or a local gov-

ernment, as defined in ORS 174.116, that currently store fuel and that are of strategic
 importance for emergency response.

8 (2) On and after January 1, 2031, facilities identified under subsection (1) of this section
9 shall store and maintain fuel sufficient for at least three weeks of normal usage.

10 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Cities with a population of at least 50,000 people shall report their plans to 11 comply with section 1 of this 2025 Act to the Oregon Department of Emergency Management 12 on or before January 1, 2027.

13 <u>SECTION 3.</u> (1) All facilities owned or operated by the state government or a local gov-14 ernment shall use renewable diesel for all diesel fuel requirements.

- 15 (2) As used in this section:
- 16 (a) "Local government" has the meaning given that term in ORS 174.116.

17 (b) "Renewable diesel" means a hydrocarbon that is derived from biomass and that is 18 chemically equivalent to petroleum diesel fuel.

- 19 (c) "State government" has the meaning given that term in ORS 174.111.
- 20 SECTION 4. Section 3 of this 2025 Act becomes operative on January 1, 2028.
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
