

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3313

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 20 through 22 and insert:

2 “(b)(A) A public charter school may give priority for admission to students who reside within  
3 the attendance boundaries that were in effect at the time a school district closed a nonchartered  
4 public school if:

5 “(i) The public charter school began to operate not more than two years after the nonchartered  
6 public school was closed;

7 “(ii) The school district that closed the nonchartered public school is the sponsor of the public  
8 charter school;

9 “(iii) The public charter school is physically located within the attendance boundaries of the  
10 closed nonchartered public school; and

11 “(iv) The school district board, through board action, approved the public charter school giving  
12 priority as described in this paragraph.

13 “(B) Nothing in this paragraph requires an amendment to a charter. A school district board may  
14 take an action described in subparagraph (A)(iv) of this paragraph at any time during the term of  
15 a charter.”.

16 On page 3, delete lines 42 through 44 and insert:

17 “(b)(A) A public charter school may give priority for admission to students who reside within  
18 the attendance boundaries that were in effect at the time a school district closed a nonchartered  
19 public school if:

20 “(i) The public charter school began to operate not more than two years after the nonchartered  
21 public school was closed;

22 “(ii) The school district that closed the nonchartered public school is the sponsor of the public  
23 charter school;

24 “(iii) The public charter school is physically located within the attendance boundaries of the  
25 closed nonchartered public school; and

26 “(iv) The school district board, through board action, approved the public charter school giving  
27 priority as described in this paragraph.

28 “(B) Nothing in this paragraph requires an amendment to a charter. A school district board may  
29 take an action described in subparagraph (A)(iv) of this paragraph at any time during the term of  
30 a charter.”.
