House Bill 3389

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON RULES (at the request of Representative Ben Bowman)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Tells the Secretary of State to study voting. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.2). Requires the Secretary of State to study elections. Directs the secretary to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to elections not later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

A BILL FOR AN ACT Relating to elections. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall study elections. The secretary shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to elections no later than September 15, 2026. SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
