SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act tells a state agency to pursue a fire protection contract with a federal agency. The contract would apply in two counties. (Flesch Readability Score: 62.7).

Directs the State Forestry Department to endeavor to enter into a fire protection contract with

the United States Forest Service that pertains to certain counties.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 2 Relating to fire protection. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. The State Forestry Department shall endeavor to enter into a fire response 4 and fire suppression contract with the United States Forest Service that: 5 (1) Pertains to fire response and fire suppression in Douglas County and Linn County. 6 (2) Is modeled after any similar, existing contract between the department and the Bureau of Land Management, to the extent practicable. 8
