

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 4129

1 On page 10 of the printed A-engrossed bill, after line 22, insert:

2 “**SECTION 6.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
3 made to the Department of Human Services by section 1 (6), chapter 610, Oregon Laws 2023,
4 for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, for aging and people with disabilities programs, is in-
5 creased by \$414,498 for carrying out sections 1 to 3 of this 2024 Act.

6 “**SECTION 7.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
7 expenditures established by section 3 (6), chapter 610, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium
8 ending June 30, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds,
9 excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter 610, Oregon Laws 2023, collected or
10 received by the Department of Human Services, for aging and people with disabilities pro-
11 grams, is increased by \$414,498 for carrying out sections 1 to 3 of this 2024 Act.

12 “**SECTION 8.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
13 made to the Department of Human Services by section 1 (2), chapter 610, Oregon Laws 2023,
14 for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, for state assessments and enterprise-wide costs, is
15 increased by \$60,041 for carrying out sections 1 to 3 of this 2024 Act.

16 “**SECTION 9.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
17 expenditures established by section 2 (2), chapter 610, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium
18 ending June 30, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or
19 other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and Medicare receipts and including federal
20 funds for indirect cost recovery, Social Security Supplemental Security Income recoveries
21 and the Child Care and Development Fund, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not
22 described in section 2, chapter 610, Oregon Laws 2023, collected or received by the Depart-
23 ment of Human Services, for state assessments and enterprise-wide costs, is increased by
24 \$766 for carrying out sections 1 to 3 of this 2024 Act.

25 “**SECTION 10.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
26 expenditures established by section 3 (2), chapter 610, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium
27 ending June 30, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds,
28 excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter 610, Oregon Laws 2023, collected or
29 received by the Department of Human Services, for state assessments and enterprise-wide
30 costs, is increased by \$52,638 for carrying out sections 1 to 3 of this 2024 Act.

31 “**SECTION 11.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
32 expenditures established by section 2 (8), chapter 610, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium
33 ending June 30, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or
34 other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and Medicare receipts and including federal
35 funds for indirect cost recovery, Social Security Supplemental Security Income recoveries

1 and the Child Care and Development Fund, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not
2 described in section 2, chapter 610, Oregon Laws 2023, collected or received by the Depart-
3 ment of Human Services, for shared services, is increased by \$158,179 for carrying out
4 sections 1 to 3 of this 2024 Act.

5 “SECTION 12. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropri-
6 ation made to the Oregon Health Authority by section 1 (2), chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023,
7 for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, for Health Systems Division - Programs, is increased
8 by \$926,738 for carrying out sections 1 to 3 of this 2024 Act.

9 “SECTION 13. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
10 expenditures established by section 5 (2), chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium
11 ending June 30, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds,
12 excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, collected or
13 received by the Oregon Health Authority, for Health Systems Division - Programs, is in-
14 creased by \$1,003,003 for carrying out sections 1 to 3 of this 2024 Act.

15 “SECTION 14. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropri-
16 ation made to the Oregon Health Authority by section 1 (7), chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023,
17 for the biennium ending June 30, 2025, for state assessments and enterprise-wide costs, is
18 increased by \$34,225 for carrying out sections 1 to 3 of this 2024 Act.

19 “SECTION 15. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
20 expenditures established by section 2 (10), chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium
21 ending June 30, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or
22 other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, tobacco tax receipts, marijuana tax re-
23 cepts, beer and wine tax receipts, provider taxes and Medicare receipts, but excluding lot-
24 tery funds and federal funds not described in section 2, chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023,
25 collected or received by the Oregon Health Authority, for shared administrative services, is
26 increased by \$1,235 for carrying out sections 1 to 3 of this 2024 Act.

27 “SECTION 16. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on
28 expenditures established by section 5 (7), chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, for the biennium
29 ending June 30, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds,
30 excluding federal funds described in section 2, chapter 591, Oregon Laws 2023, collected or
31 received by the Oregon Health Authority, for state assessments and enterprise-wide costs,
32 is increased by \$27,688 for carrying out sections 1 to 3 of this 2024 Act.”.

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
