House Joint Resolution 5

Sponsored by Representative SMITH G (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The measure asks voters to fix the maximum age to seek statewide elected office or to seek to be a member of the state Senate or the state House. The measure asks voters to say yes or no at the next general election. (Flesch Readability Score: 66.9). Proposes an amendment to the Oregon Constitution to establish a maximum age beyond which

candidates for election or reelection to executive branch statewide elected office or the office of State Senator or State Representative may not seek elective office.

Refers the proposed amendment to the people for their approval or rejection at the next regular general election.

1	JOINT RESOLUTION
2	Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:
3	PARAGRAPH 1. The Constitution of the State of Oregon is amended by creating a new section
4	25 to be added to and made a part of Article II, such section to read:
5	SECTION 25. A candidate may not seek election or reelection if the candidate is 72 years
6	of age or older on the date of the election and the office being sought is:
7	(1) Governor, Secretary of State, State Treasurer or any other statewide elected office
8	in the Executive Branch;
9	(2) State Senator; or
10	(3) State Representative.

12	PARAGRAPH 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be submitted to the
13	people for their approval or rejection at the next regular general election held throughout
14	this state.
