

# Senate Bill 1184

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives money to the legislature to pay for a year-round assistant for each member. (Flesch Readability Score: 63.6).

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Legislative Assembly to support a year-round legislative assistant position for each member of the Legislative Assembly.

Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium be-**  
5 **ginning July 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$\_\_ to support one year-round**  
6 **legislative assistant position for each member of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly of the**  
7 **State of Oregon.**

8 **(2) There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium beginning July**  
9 **1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$\_\_ to support one year-round legislative**  
10 **assistant position for each member of the Eighty-fourth Legislative Assembly of the State**  
11 **of Oregon.**

12 **SECTION 2. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
13 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect**  
14 **July 1, 2025.**
