

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED SENATE BILL 1506

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

March 6

1 On page 6 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 42, delete “must” and insert “may”.

2 On page 7, line 5, delete “State Council” and insert “Governor”.

3 In line 7, after the period insert “The individual appointed to this position must be a member
4 of the uniformed service. The Department of Education of the State of Oregon shall assist the mili-
5 tary family education liaison in the performance of the duties of the position.”.

6 In line 10, after the period insert “The individual appointed to this position must have experi-
7 ence in the education of military children.”.

8 In line 12, after “Council” insert a period and delete the rest of the line and delete line 13.

9 Delete pages 16 and 17 and insert:

10 **“SECTION 2. (1) If the Interstate Commission levies an annual assessment as described
11 in Article XIV of the Interstate Compact on Educational Opportunity for Military Children
12 under section 1 of this 2014 Act, the Department of Education shall fund the annual assess-
13 ment.**

14 **“(2) For purposes of funding the annual assessment, the department may accept contri-
15 butions of funds and assistance from any source, public or private, and agree to conditions
16 placed on the funds not inconsistent with the purposes of the Interstate Compact on Edu-
17 cational Opportunity for Military Children under section 1 of this 2014 Act.**

“ESTABLISHING STATE COUNCIL

“(Establishment; Qualification of Members)

22 **“SECTION 3. There is established a State Council for Educational Opportunity for Mili-
23 tary Children, as described in Article VIII of the Interstate Compact on Educational Oppor-
24 tunity for Military Children under section 1 of this 2014 Act, consisting of the military family
25 education liaison and the compact commissioner. The Governor may appoint other individ-
26 uals to the state council and shall make a good faith effort to ensure that other individuals
27 appointed are individuals who are described in Article VIII of the Interstate Compact on
28 Educational Opportunity for Military Children under section 1 of this 2014 Act and who are
29 well informed on the principles of education of military children.**

“(Meetings)

33 **“SECTION 4. The State Council for Educational Opportunity for Military Children shall
34 meet at least once every three months through the use of telephone or other electronic
35 means and in accordance with ORS 192.610 to 192.690 and 192.672.**

“SECTION 5. The Oregon Military Department shall provide administrative support to the State Council for Educational Opportunity for Military Children.”

“(Authority to Adopt Policies)”

“SECTION 6. The State Council for Educational Opportunity for Military Children may adopt policies to carry out the duties assigned to the state council.”

On page 18, line 3, delete “10” and insert “7”.

In line 6, delete “11” and insert “8”.
