Senate Bill 214

Sponsored by Senator SMITH DB (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: Makes the PUC do a study on the status of renewable energy projects in this state, including any failures. Makes the PUC submit a report on its findings. (Flesch Readability Score: 62.7).

Requires the Public Utility Commission to investigate the status of renewable energy projects in Oregon, including any project failures. Directs the commission to submit its findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to energy no later than September 15, 2026. Sunsets January 2, 2027.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the status of renewable energy projects in Oregon.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Public Utility Commission shall conduct a study to investigate the

5 status of renewable energy projects in Oregon, including any project failures such as:

- 6 (a) Maintenance issues;
- 7 (b) Management issues;

8 (c) Project delays;

- 9 (d) Project cost overruns; and
- 10 (e) Failures to generate expected amounts of energy from a project.
- 11 (2) The commission shall submit a report on its findings in the manner provided by ORS

12 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the

- 13 Legislative Assembly related to energy no later than September 15, 2026.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
