

Senate Bill 227

Sponsored by Senator MANNING JR (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act directs BOLI to conduct a wage theft study. (Flesch Readability Score: 78.2).

Requires the Bureau of Labor and Industries to study issues related to wage theft. Directs the bureau to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to labor and business not later than September 15, 2026.

2 Relating to wage theft.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Bureau of Labor and Industries shall study issues related to wage theft.**
5 **The bureau shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include**
6 **recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly re-**
7 **lated to labor and business no later than September 15, 2026.**

8 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.**
