

Senate Bill 489

Sponsored by Senator SMITH DB (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The measure tells the LAC head to cause OLIS updates to let proposed changes and info about a bill be posted online whether or not the bill has a hearing. (Flesch Readability Score: 60.7).

Directs the Legislative Administrator to cause updates to the Oregon Legislative Information System to permit amendments and informational material to be posted and associated online with a legislative measure without regard to whether the measure is scheduled for a hearing.

Sunset on January 2, 2030.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to the Oregon Legislative Information System; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Legislative Administrator shall develop refinements and updates to the**
5 **Oregon Legislative Information System to permit amendments and informational material**
6 **to be posted and associated online with the legislative measure to which the amendments and**
7 **informational material relate without regard to whether the measure is scheduled for a**
8 **hearing.**

9 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2030.**

10 **SECTION 3. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025**
11 **regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
