83rd OREGON LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY--2025 Regular Session

Senate Bill 531

Sponsored by Senator PATTERSON, Representative PHAM H; Senator CAMPOS (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**. The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act gives some money to DAS and says that DAS has to give that money to the Oregon Wellness Program. (Flesch Readability Score: 76.7).

Directs the Oregon Department of Administrative Services to distribute moneys to the Oregon Wellness Program for specified purposes.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to a wellness program for Oregon health care professionals; and prescribing an effective 3 date.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 SECTION 1. The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall distribute moneys

6 to the Oregon Wellness Program for the purpose of supporting the program. The moneys

7 may be used by the program for supporting the well-being of eligible health care profes-

8 sionals in this state through counseling, education and research.

9 <u>SECTION 2.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-10 ated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, for the biennium beginning July 11 1, 2025, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,600,000 for the purpose of carrying out the

12 provisions of section 1 of this 2025 Act.

13 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2025 14 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.
