SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** The statement includes a measure digest written in compliance with applicable readability standards.

Digest: The Act would let Business Oregon take stock of loans and grants made by the state to develop the economy. (Flesch Readability Score: 63.8).

Authorizes the Oregon Business Development Department to survey state loan and grant programs for economic development.

Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to economic development; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Oregon Business Development Department may conduct a survey of

5 existing state loan and grant programs to identify gaps in access to funds for economic de-6 velopment. If the department conducts the survey, the department shall submit a report of

7 its findings, in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, to the interim committees of the Leg-

8 islative Assembly related to economic development not later than September 15, 2026. The

9 report may include recommendations for legislation.

10 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.

11 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 12 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect 13 on its passage.
