 - (3) Two members appointed by the Secretary of Education:
- 11 <u>(i) One of whom shall be a teacher of career and technical</u>
 12 <u>agriculture from a school district.</u>
 - (ii) One of whom shall be a teacher of career and technical agriculture from a career and technical center.
 - (4) Two members appointed by the Secretary of Agriculture:
 - (i) One of whom shall be a representative of the
 - agricultural marketing industry.
- 18 <u>(ii) One of whom shall be an agricultural sciences faculty</u>

 - (5) Two members appointed by the President pro tempore of the Senate:
 - (i) One of whom shall be a farmer.

 - (6) Two members appointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate:
 - (i) One of whom shall be a member of a school district occupational advisory committee.
 - (ii) One of whom shall be a member of the business community with knowledge of agricultural education.
 - (7) Two members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives:
 - (i) One of whom shall be a farmer.
 - (ii) One of whom shall be a faculty member of the College of Agricultural Sciences of The Pennsylvania State University.
 - (8) Two members appointed by the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives:
 - (i) One of whom shall be a member of the business community with knowledge of agricultural education.
- 40 <u>(ii) One of whom shall be an individual with a background in</u> 41 <u>or knowledge of agricultural education.</u>

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- 43 (g.1) To the extent practicable, from members appointed
 44 under subsection (f.1), an equal number shall draw lots to serve
 45 for a term of three years, for a term of two years and for a
- 46 term of one year. Thereafter, all members shall be appointed for
- 47 <u>a term of three years. Members shall continue to serve until a</u>
- 48 <u>successor is appointed. If members are not initially appointed</u>
- 49 by October 1, 2024, the Secretary of Education and Secretary of
- 50 Agriculture shall jointly appoint any qualified individual to
- 51 <u>fill the vacancy.</u>
