The department shall ensure that the 24 report, at a minimum, includes all of the following: 25 26 (1) A comprehensive review of the department's efforts 27 to raise awareness of the 988 suicide and crisis lifeline, detailing activities, key metrics utilized and budget 28

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allocations and expenditures.

(2) A performance summary, including call volume data

and the usage of the 988 suicide and crisis lifeline chat and text functions, key findings, recommendations and any preliminary or final reports generated from efforts to raise awareness of the 988 suicide and crisis lifeline.

- (3) Information on 988 suicide and crisis lifeline operations, including a breakdown of calls received, in-State answer rates, services provided to callers and the percentage of calls requiring crisis intervention.
- (4) Insights or recommendations from the consultations specified under section 53A02(b) (relating to 988 public education campaign).
- (5) A summary of ongoing or planned initiatives to further promote awareness of the 988 suicide and crisis lifeline.
- (b) Updated report.--Within one year of the submission of the report under subsection (a), the department shall submit an updated report to the chairperson and minority chairperson of the Health and Human Services Committee of the Senate and the chairperson and minority chairperson of the Human Services

 Committee of the House of Representatives. The department shall ensure that the updated report includes all of the following:
 - (1) Updated statistics on 988 suicide and crisis lifeline operations.
 - (2) Information on new campaigns or initiatives to raise awareness of the 988 suicide and crisis lifeline, including metrics, target audiences and performance evaluations.
- (3) The impact of the new campaigns or initiatives under paragraph (2) on the utilization of the 988 suicide and crisis lifeline, including the in-State answer rate, call volume and the number of Pennsylvanians receiving services or referrals.
