- 9 (a) Total spending by the Commonwealth shall not exceed the 10 spending limit in any fiscal year. The spending limit for any fiscal year shall be equal to the spending during the 11
- immediately prior fiscal year, adjusted by the sum of: 12
- 13 (i) The average of the percentage change in the annual
- United States Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-14
- U), as reported by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau 15
- 16 of Labor Statistics, for each of the immediately preceding three 17 calendar years.
- (ii) The average of the percentage change in the resident 18 19
  - population in this Commonwealth, as reported by the United States Census Bureau for July 1 of each year, for the
- 21 immediately preceding three calendar years.

  - (b) The percentage of the rate of change calculated under
- 23 subsection (a) used in any fiscal year to adjust the spending limit may be increased for that fiscal year by the affirmative 24
- vote of three-fourths of the members elected to each House of 25

- 27 calculated under subsection (a) may be changed by the procedure
- outlined in section 1(a) of Article XI. 28
- 29 (c) Total spending by the Commonwealth means all
- appropriations and authorizations from the General Fund and 30

- or receipts restricted by laws in effect as of January 1 of the 32
