

## AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 1200

1 Amend Bill, page 3, by inserting between lines 19 and 20

2 (f) Temporary regulations.--

3 (1) In order to facilitate the prompt implementation of  
4 this section, the department may promulgate temporary  
5 regulations. The department shall transmit notice of the  
6 temporary regulations to the Legislative Reference Bureau for  
7 publication in the next available issue of the Pennsylvania  
8 Bulletin. The temporary regulations shall expire no later  
9 than two years following publication in the Pennsylvania  
10 Bulletin. The department may promulgate temporary regulations  
11 not subject to:

12 (i) Section 612 of the act of April 9, 1929  
13 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of  
14 1929.

15 (ii) Sections 201, 202, 203, 204 and 205 of the act  
16 of July 31, 1968 (P.L.769, No.240), referred to as the  
17 Commonwealth Documents Law.

18 (iii) Sections 204(b) and 301(10) of the act of  
19 October 15, 1980 (P.L.950, No.164), known as the  
20 Commonwealth Attorneys Act.

21 (iv) The act of June 25, 1982 (P.L.633, No.181),  
22 known as the Regulatory Review Act.

23 (2) The department's authority to adopt temporary  
24 regulations under paragraph (1) shall expire six months after  
25 the effective date of this paragraph. Regulations adopted  
26 after this period shall be promulgated as provided by law.

27 (3) The temporary regulations promulgated under this  
28 subsection shall meet all the following criteria:

29 (i) Be based on consideration of formal and informal  
30 input from all stakeholders.

31 (ii) Establish requirements for driver education  
32 instructor applicants that include passage of a maximum  
33 50 multiple choice question examination, embracing  
34 subject matter pertinent only to the Pennsylvania  
35 Driver's Manual published by the department and provide  
36 applicants three opportunities to pass the examination  
37 with a score of 70% without needing to submit a new  
38 application.
