12 (15) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a
13 governing body of a political subdivision or public official
14 may not enact or enforce an ordinance, executive order or
15 directive or take any other official action that would be
16 inconsistent with the provisions of this section or direct a
17 law enforcement agency with appropriate jurisdiction to not
18 assist the special prosecutor if able. An ordinance,
19 executive order or directive or any other official action in
20 violation of this section shall be null and void.

21 (b) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
22 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
23 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

24 "Law enforcement agency." Any of the following:

25 (1) A public agency of a political subdivision having
26 general police powers and charged with making arrests in
27 connection with the enforcement of the criminal or traffic
28 laws.

29 (2) A campus police or university police department, as
30 used in section 2416 of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177,
31 No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, certified
32 by the Office of Attorney General as a criminal justice
33 agency under the definition of "criminal justice agency" in
34 18 Pa.C.S. § 9102 (relating to definitions).

- 1 (3) A railroad or street railway police department
2 formed with officers commissioned under 22 Pa.C.S. Ch. 33
3 (relating to railroad and street railway police) or any prior
4 statute providing for the commissioning.
5 (4) An airport authority police department.
6 (5) A county park police force under section 2511(b) of
7 the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), known as The
8 County Code.
