**SUMMARY:** Amends the Barbers' License Law to authorize licensed barber schools to provide a portion of instruction through distance education. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation amends the Barbers' License Law of 1931 to provide licensed barber schools the ability to offer up to 50% of the school's curriculum through distance education.

Under the legislation, a student at a licensed barber school may only earn barbering study and training hours through distance education for theory-based subjects. A licensed barber school's curriculum may not offer practical demonstrations through distance education.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
