SUMMARY:

This bill sets the minimum number of days or hours of instruction a school entity is required to provide within the school year.

ANALYSIS:

House Bill 1507 provides that, for 2023/24 and each school year thereafter, a school entity shall provide a minimum of 180 days of instruction or a certain number of hours of instruction – 900 for elementary or 990 for secondary. Current law requires 180 days and 900/990 hours of instruction.

A school entity is defined as a school district, intermediate unit, or area career and technical school.

House Bill 1507 would take effect immediately.

FISCAL IMPACT:

House Bill 1507 would have no adverse fiscal impact on commonwealth funds.
