SUMMARY: Amends Title 75 (Vehicle Code) to authorize PennDOT to issue a special registration plate for recipients of the Air Medal. This legislation would take effect in 120 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation adds Section 1366.2 (Special plates for recipients of Air Medal) to the Vehicle Code to authorize a new registration plate (license plate) for recipients of the Air Medal. In addition to the annual registration cost a \$23 fee is required, along with documentation promulgated by PennDOT.

The Air Medal license plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than 14,000 pounds.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, this legislation would cost roughly \$40,000 for systems changes and \$500 for the license plate design. These costs could be absorbed within current allocated funds. If 5,000 of these specialty plates are sold, this would result in \$115,000 in revenue to the Motor License Fund.
