SUMMARY:

House Bill 2381 amends Title 63 (Professions and Occupations (State Licensed)) to provide for the ability for licensing boards that are subject to an interstate licensure compact the power to promulgate temporary rules for compact implementation.

ANALYSIS:

This bill adds a section to Title 63 giving licensing boards or commissions under the bureau that are subject to an interstate licensure compact the authority to promulgate one-time temporary regulations necessary for the implementation of each licensure compact enacted by the General Assembly.

These temporary regulations will not be subject to:

- Sections 201, 202, 203 and 205 of the Commonwealth Documents Law;
- Section 204(b) of the Commonwealth Attorneys Act; and
- The Regulatory Review Act.

Any temporary regulation promulgated under this section shall expire no later than three years following the publication of the temporary regulation in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This bill will have no impact on commonwealth funds.
