## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 23, 1970 (P.L.563, No.195), entitled "An act establishing rights in public employes to organize and bargain collectively through selected representatives; 3 defining public employes to include employes of nonprofit 4 organizations and institutions; providing compulsory 5 mediation and fact-finding, for collective bargaining 7 impasses; providing arbitration for certain public employes for collective bargaining impasses; defining the scope of 8 collective bargaining; establishing unfair employe and 9 employer practices; prohibiting strikes for certain public 10 employes; permitting strikes under limited conditions; 11 providing penalties for violations; and establishing 12 procedures for implementation," in unfair practices, further 13 providing for prohibitions. 14 15 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 16 hereby enacts as follows: 17 Section 1. Section 1201(b) of the act of July 23, 1970 18 (P.L.563, No.195), known as the Public Employe Relations Act, is 19 amended by adding a clause to read: Section 1201. \* \* \* 20 21 Employe organizations, their agents, or representatives,

or public employes are prohibited from:

- 2 (10) Using public funds to influence the decision of an
- 3 employe or an employe of a subcontractor on whether to join,
- 4 <u>support or oppose a labor organization that represents or seeks</u>
- 5 to represent an employe.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
