AN ACT

- 1 Establishing the Local Business COVID-19 Loan Interest Grant
- 2 Program and the Local Business COVID-19 Loan Interest Grant
- Program Account; and providing for powers and duties of the
- 4 Department of Community and Economic Development.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Short title.
- 8 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Local
- 9 Business COVID-19 Loan Interest Grant Program Act.
- 10 Section 2. Definitions.
- 11 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 12 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 13 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 14 "Account." The Local Business COVID-19 Loan Interest Grant
- 15 Program Account established under section 5.
- 16 "COVID-19 disaster emergency." The proclamation of disaster
- 17 emergency issued by the Governor on March 6, 2020, published at

- 1 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21, 2020), and any renewal of the state of
- 2 disaster emergency.
- 3 "Department." The Department of Community and Economic
- 4 Development of the Commonwealth.
- 5 "Program." The Local Business COVID-19 Loan Interest Grant
- 6 Program established under section 3.
- 7 "Small business." A person that:
- 8 (1) is engaged in a for-profit enterprise;
- 9 (2) employs 100 or fewer individuals; and
- 10 (3) has been granted a loan for assistance during the
- 11 COVID-19 disaster emergency.
- 12 Section 3. Local Business COVID-19 Loan Interest Grant Program.
- 13 (a) Establishment.--The Local Business COVID-19 Loan
- 14 Interest Grant Program is established within the department for
- 15 the purpose of distributing grants to small businesses to
- 16 subsidize interest charged on loans for assistance during the
- 17 COVID-19 disaster emergency.
- 18 (b) Eligibility.--To be eligible for a grant, a small
- 19 business must meet all of the following:
- 20 (1) Have been impacted by the COVID-19 disaster
- emergency.
- 22 (2) Be registered and in good standing with the
- 23 Department of Revenue.
- 24 (3) Have applied to and been approved for a loan during
- 25 the COVID-19 disaster emergency.
- 26 (c) Procedure. -- The following shall apply:
- 27 (1) A small business shall apply for a grant under this
- section on a form furnished by the department providing the
- facts establishing eligibility. An application under this
- paragraph is subject to 18 Pa.C.S. § 4904 (relating to

- 1 unsworn falsification to authorities).
- 2 (2) The department shall review the application to determine eligibility.
- 4 (3) Within 30 days of receipt of the application, the department shall make an eligibility and grant determination.
- 6 (d) Grants. -- The following shall apply:
- 7 (1) The maximum grant amount to be awarded under the 8 program to a small business is \$20,000 or the aggregate 9 amount of interest charged on a loan to the small business,
- 10 whichever is less.
- 11 (2) Grant applications shall be reviewed and grants
- 12 approved on a first-come, first-served basis until available
- money is exhausted.
- 14 Section 4. Powers and duties of department.
- 15 The department shall adopt guidelines to administer the
- 16 program.
- 17 Section 5. Local Business COVID-19 Loan Interest Grant Program
- 18 Account.
- 19 A restricted account is established in the State Treasury to
- 20 be known as the Local Business COVID-19 Loan Interest Grant
- 21 Program Account. Money in the account shall be used to award
- 22 grants under the program.
- 23 Section 6. Appropriation.
- The sum of \$7,500,000, or as much as may be necessary, is
- 25 appropriated to the department from the Small Business First
- 26 Fund to carry out the purpose of this act.
- 27 Section 7. Termination.
- The program and account shall terminate December 31, 2021, or
- 29 one year following the expiration or termination of the COVID-19
- 30 disaster emergency, whichever is later, and the money remaining

- 1 in the account shall be transferred to the Small Business First
- 2 Fund.
- 3 Section 8. Effective date.
- 4 This act shall take effect immediately.
