AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for examination of applicant for
3 driver's license.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 1508 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsections to
8 read:

9 § 1508. Examination of applicant for driver's license.

11 (e) ~~Third party~~ THIRD-PARTY testing.--The department may <--
12 authorize a third party to administer the portion of the
13 examination that demonstrates the applicant's ability to
14 exercise ordinary and reasonable control in the operation of a
15 motor vehicle of the type or class of vehicles for which the
16 applicant desires a license to drive. ~~Third party~~ THIRD-PARTY <--

1 providers shall only administer exams required in this section  
2 if:

3 (1) The test is the same test as that which would  
4 otherwise be administered by the department.

5 (2) The third party has entered into an agreement with  
6 the department, and the agreement has not been terminated by  
7 the department.

8 (f) ~~Driver License Examiners~~ LAYOFFS.--No layoffs shall <--  
9 occur in the classifications known as Driver License Examiner,  
10 Driver License Examiner Assistant and Driver License Center  
11 Supervisor as a result of ~~this section~~ THIRD-PARTY TESTING UNDER <--  
12 SUBSECTION (E).

13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
