- 20 SECTION 1. TITLE 68 OF THE PENNSYLVANIA CONSOLIDATED
- 21 STATUTES IS AMENDED BY ADDING SECTIONS TO READ:
- 22 § 3323. OUTDOOR SOLAR ACCESS FOR DRYING CLOTHES.
- 23 (A) GENERAL RULE. -- EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN THE DECLARATION, AN

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- 24 ASSOCIATION SHALL BE PROHIBITED FROM IMPOSING ANY UNREASONABLE
- 25 RESTRICTION THAT PROHIBITS A PERSON WHO OCCUPIES A UNIT FROM
- 26 OUTDOOR SOLAR ACCESS FOR DRYING CLOTHES WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF
- 27 A UNIT OR THE LIMITED COMMON ELEMENTS ASSIGNED TO THE UNIT.
- 28 (B) LIMITATIONS.--THE DRYING OF CLOTHES OUTDOORS SHALL BE
- 29 LIMITED TO ASSOCIATION-APPROVED AREAS OF A UNIT OR THE LIMITED
- 30 COMMON ELEMENTS ASSIGNED TO THE UNIT AND SHALL BE OUT OF VIEW

- 1 FROM THE FRONT ENTRANCES OR PUBLIC AREAS OF THE ASSOCIATION.
- 2 (C) RULES AND REGULATIONS.--AN ASSOCIATION MAY ADOPT
- 3 REASONABLE RULES AND REGULATIONS DETAILING THE TIME, PLACE AND
- 4 MANNER OF THE DRYING OF CLOTHES OUTDOORS AND PROHIBIT THE DRYING
- 5 OF CLOTHES OUTDOORS IF THE DRYING OF CLOTHES POSES A SAFETY OR
- 6 FIRE HAZARD, IMPEDES PROPER EVACUATION IN THE CASE OF AN
- 7 EMERGENCY OR OBSTRUCTS THE VIEW FROM, OR ACCESS TO, OTHER UNITS.
- 8 (D) CONSTRUCTION. -- NOTHING IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE
- 9 CONSTRUED TO SUPERSEDE THE LEGAL AUTHORITY OF AN ASSOCIATION TO
- 10 ADOPT AND ENFORCE ANY BYLAW, RULE OR REGULATION ON ANY MATTER
- 11 OTHER THAN THE PROVISION OF OUTDOOR SOLAR ACCESS FOR DRYING
- 12 <u>CLOTHES AS SPECIFIED UNDER THIS SECTION.</u>
- 13 § 4324. OUTDOOR SOLAR ACCESS FOR DRYING CLOTHES.
- 14 (A) GENERAL RULE. -- EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN THE DECLARATION, AN
- 15 <u>ASSOCIATION SHALL BE PROHIBITED FROM IMPOSING ANY UNREASONABLE</u>
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- 25 CLOTHES AS SPECIFIED UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 26 SECTION 2. THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT IN 60 DAYS.
