## AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An  
2 act relating to the public school system, including certain  
3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial  
4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the  
5 laws relating thereto," in terms and courses of study,  
6 providing for calculation of average daily membership for a  
7 dual credit course.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known  
11 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a  
12 section to read:

13 Section 1525.1. Calculation of Average Daily Membership for  
14 a Dual Credit Course.--(a) Notwithstanding 22 Pa. Code § 11.5  
15 (relating to part-time attendance for potential graduates) or  
16 any other provision of law, each high school student who is  
17 enrolled in a dual credit course through an agreement entered  
18 into in accordance with section 1525 may be included in the  
19 school entity's average daily membership.

1 ~~(b) By September 1 of each school year~~ SEPTEMBER 1, 2024, <--  
2 the Department of Education shall issue a report on the data  
3 compiled by the department in section 1525(e) to the chair and  
4 minority chair of the Appropriations Committee of the Senate,  
5 the chair and minority chair of the Appropriations Committee of  
6 the House of Representatives, the chair and minority chair of  
7 the Education Committee of the Senate and the chair and minority  
8 chair of the Education Committee of the House of  
9 Representatives.

11 SECTION 2. THE ADDITION OF SECTION 1525.1(A) OF THE ACT <--  
12 SHALL APPLY RETROACTIVE TO JULY 1, 2023.

13 Section ~~2~~ 3. This act shall take effect immediately. <--
