## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in reimbursements by Commonwealth and 5 between school districts, providing for accelerated fair 6 funding. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 11 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 12 section to read: Section 2502.55. Accelerated Fair Funding. -- (a) The General 13 Assembly finds and declares that, to fulfill its duties to 14 15 maintain and support a thorough and efficient system of public 16 education to serve the needs of this Commonwealth under section 17 14 of Article III of the Constitution of Pennsylvania, the 18 inequities resulting from not applying the student-weighted basic education funding formula to all basic education funding 19

must be corrected by prioritizing new funding for school

- 2 education funding.
- 3 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this act to the
- 4 contrary, for the 2020-2021 school year through the 2030-2031
- 5 school year, the lesser of \$150,000,000 or the annual positive
- 6 change in the amount appropriated for payment of basic education
- 7 <u>funding to school districts shall be distributed to school</u>
- 8 <u>districts receiving less than their fair share of State basic</u>
- 9 <u>education funding.</u>
- 10 (c) A school district receiving less than the school
- 11 <u>district's fair share shall receive a prorated share of the</u>
- 12 <u>amount determined in subsection (b) based upon the share of the</u>
- 13 total of the negative differences calculated in subsection (d)
- 14 <u>(3).</u>
- 15 <u>(d) The process for determining school districts receiving</u>
- 16 <u>less than their fair share of State basic education funding</u>
- 17 under this section shall be as follows:
- 18 (1) For each school district, multiply the product in
- 19 section 2502.53(b)(2)(i) by the total amount allocated to school
- 20 districts in section 2502.53(b)(1).
- 21 (2) For each school district, divide the product in
- 22 paragraph (1) by the sum of the products in section 2502.53(b)
- 23 (2)(i) for all school districts.
- 24 (3) For each school district, subtract the quotient in
- 25 paragraph (2) from the school district's allocation in section
- 26 <u>2502.53(b)(1)</u>.
- 27 (e) For purposes of this section, a school district receives
- 28 less than the school district's fair share of State basic
- 29 education funding if the calculation for the school district
- 30 results in a negative difference under subsection (d)(3).

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
