AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in registration of vehicles, providing for Blue
3 Star Family plate.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 1366.2. Blue Star Family plate.

9 (a) General rule.--Upon application of a family member of a
10 person who is an active duty service member in the military,
11 accompanied by a fee of \$20 which shall be in addition to the
12 annual registration fee and by such documentation as the
13 department shall require, the department shall issue to the
14 family member a special registration plate designating the
15 vehicle so licensed as belonging to a family member of a person
16 serving on active duty in the military. The department shall
17 design and produce the special registration plate carrying the

1 Blue Star which signifies that a family member is an active duty
2 service member. The words "Blue Star Family" shall be clearly
3 displayed along the bottom of the plate. The special
4 registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck
5 with a registered gross weight of not more than 14,000 pounds.

6 (b) Documentation required.--An applicant for a Blue Star
7 Family plate shall certify on a form approved by the department
8 that the applicant is a family member of a person who is an
9 active duty service member in the military.

10 (c) Definition.--As used in this section, the term "family
11 member" includes the following:

- 12 (1) Mother.
- 13 (2) Father.
- 14 (3) Stepmother.
- 15 (4) Stepfather.
- 16 (5) Mother through adoption.
- 17 (6) Father through adoption.
- 18 (7) Foster mother in loco parentis.
- 19 (8) Foster father in loco parentis.
- 20 (9) Son.
- 21 (10) Daughter.
- 22 (11) Stepson.
- 23 (12) Stepdaughter.
- 24 (13) Son by adoption.
- 25 (14) Daughter by adoption.
- 26 (15) Brother.
- 27 (16) Sister.
- 28 (17) Half-brother.
- 29 (18) Half-sister.
- 30 (19) Grandfather.

1 (20) Grandmother.

2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
