A JOINT RESOLUTION

- Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, providing for health care as a human right.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby resolves as follows:
- 5 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 6 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 7 That Article I be amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 30. Health care as a human right.
- 9 <u>It is the obligation of the State to ensure that every</u>
- 10 resident of this Commonwealth has access to cost-effective,
- 11 clinically appropriate and affordable health care as a
- 12 <u>fundamental right as well as the opportunity to achieve and</u>
- 13 enjoy the highest attainable standard of physical and mental
- 14 health.
- 15 Section 2. The following procedure applies to the proposed
- 16 constitutional amendment in this joint resolution:

- (1) Upon the first passage by the General Assembly of the amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania.
- Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of 6 the amendment, the Secretary of the Commonwealth shall 7 proceed immediately to comply with the advertising 8 requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution 9 10 of Pennsylvania. The Secretary of the Commonwealth shall 11 submit the amendment to the qualified electors of this 12 Commonwealth at the first general or municipal election which meets the requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the 13 Constitution of Pennsylvania. 14
