## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in Commonwealth services, providing for firefighting protective equipment.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 35 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
8	§ 7390. Firefighting protective equipment.
9	(a) Warning labels.
10	(1) A manufacturer that produces or sells personal
11	protective equipment for firefighting entities in this
12	Commonwealth containing PFAS chemicals shall affix a warning
13	label to the product that indicates that the product contains
14	perfluorooctane (PFOS) or perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA) and
15	provide a written notice to the purchaser at the time of the
16	sale that includes:
17	(A) WARNING LABELS A MANUFACTURER OF PERSONAL PROTECTIVE <

- 1 EQUIPMENT USED IN FIRE PREVENTION, FIREFIGHTING OR FIRE CONTROL
- 2 <u>ACTIVITIES SHALL AFFIX A WARNING LABEL TO SUCH PRODUCT SOLD FOR</u>
- 3 USE IN THIS COMMONWEALTH THAT INDICATES IF THE PRODUCT CONTAINS
- 4 A PFAS CHEMICAL. THE FOLLOWING SHALL APPLY:
- 5 (1) A MANUFACTURER OF PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT USED
- 6 <u>IN FIRE PREVENTION, FIREFIGHTING OR FIRE CONTROL ACTIVITIES</u>
- 7 SHALL PROVIDE A WRITTEN NOTICE TO THE PURCHASER AT THE TIME
- 8 OF THE SALE THAT INCLUDES:
- 9 <u>(i) A statement that OF WHETHER the personal</u> <--
- 10 <u>protective equipment contains PFAS chemicals.</u>
- 11 <u>(ii) The reason that the personal protective</u>
- 12 <u>equipment contains PFAS chemicals-, IF APPLICABLE.</u> <--
- 13 (2) A MANUFACTURER OR INDIVIDUAL IS NOT PRECLUDED FROM
- 14 PROVIDING FURTHER GUIDANCE ON THE LIMITATIONS OR RESTRICTIONS
- ON PFAS CHEMICALS IN PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT IN
- 16 ADDITION TO THE WRITTEN NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1).
- 17 (3) The manufacturer and purchaser of the personal <--
- 18 protective equipment containing perfluorooctane (PFOS) or <--
- 19 perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA) A PFAS CHEMICAL shall retain <
- 20 the written notice under this section on file REQUIRED UNDER <--
- 21 PARAGRAPH (1) for at least three years from the date of
- 22 purchase.
- 23 (b) Enforcement.--The Office of the State Fire Commissioner
- 24 shall enforce the provisions of this section.
- 25 (c) Violations.--
- 26 (1) A manufacturer or person shall be subject to a civil
- 27 <u>penalty not to exceed \$5,000 for a first violation and</u>
- \$10,000 for each subsequent violation.
- 29 (2) Money collected under paragraph (1) shall be
- 30 transferred to the department for the Fire Company Grant

- 1 <u>Program and the Emergency Medical Services Grant Program.</u>
- 2 (d) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 3 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 4 <u>subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 5 <u>"Firefighting entity." An entity that engages in fire</u>
- 6 prevention, firefighting or fire control activities in this
- 7 <u>Commonwealth. The term shall include municipal fire departments</u>
- 8 <u>and volunteer fire companies.</u>
- 9 "Manufacturer." A person that manufactures, imports or
- 10 distributes domestically personal protective equipment for a
- 11 <u>firefighting entity.</u>
- "Personal protective equipment." Items designed, intended or
- 13 <u>marketed to be worn by firefighting entity personnel in the</u>
- 14 performance of fire and rescue activities, including jackets,
- 15 pants, shoes, gloves, helmets and respiratory equipment.
- 16 "PFAS chemical." A fluorinated organic chemical that
- 17 contains at least one fully fluorinated carbon atom and is

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- 18 designed to be fully functional in formulations of class B-
- 19 firefighting foam.
- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
