Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 1 act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in charter schools, further providing 5 for enrollment. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 8 9 Section 1. Section 1723-A(d)(1) of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is 10 11 amended and the subsection is amended by adding a paragraph to 12 read: 13 Section 1723-A. Enrollment.--* * * 14 [Enrollment] Except as provided under paragraph 15 (1.1), enrollment of students in a charter school or cyber 16 charter school shall not be subject to a cap or otherwise 17 limited by any past or future action of a board of school directors, a board of control established under Article XVII-B, 18

a special board of control established under section 692 or any

- 1 other governing authority, unless agreed to by the charter
- 2 school or cyber charter school as part of a written charter
- 3 pursuant to section 1720-A.
- 4 (1.1) Enrollment of students in a charter school or regional
- 5 <u>charter school shall be subject to a cap on students who reside</u>
- 6 <u>in the district or districts in which the charter school is</u>
- 7 physically located or in which the regional charter school is
- 8 <u>chartered as part of a written charter under section 1720-A. The</u>
- 9 <u>enrollment cap shall be approved by the local board of school</u>
- 10 directors of a school district or by the local boards of school
- 11 <u>directors of a school district in the case of a regional charter</u>
- 12 school. The enrollment cap shall not preclude a charter school
- 13 <u>from enrolling students from districts outside of the physical</u>
- 14 location of the charter school or in the case of a regional
- 15 <u>charter school, from districts outside of where the regional</u>
- 16 <u>charter school is chartered</u>.
