AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in registration of vehicles, providing for a canine
3 health special registration plate.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 1369.3. Canine health special registration plate.

9 The department, in consultation with the Canine Health Board,
10 shall design a canine health special registration plate. Upon
11 application of any person, accompanied by a fee of \$35 which
12 shall be in addition to the annual registration fee, the
13 department shall issue the plate for a passenger car, motor
14 home, trailer or truck with a registered gross weight of not
15 more than 10,000 pounds. The Dog Law Restricted Account shall
16 receive \$15 of each additional fee for this plate.

17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
