AN ACT

1 Amending Titles 24 (Education) and 71 (State Government) of the
2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in administration and
3 miscellaneous provisions relating to retirement for school
4 employees, providing for bills implementing supplemental
5 annuities; and, in administration, funds, accounts and
6 general provisions relating to retirement for State employees
7 and officers, providing for bills implementing supplemental
8 annuities.

9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
10 hereby enacts as follows:

11 Section 1. Title 24 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
12 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

13 § 8511. Bills implementing supplemental annuities.

14 A bill implementing a supplemental annuity under this part
15 may not be given second consideration by the Senate or House of
16 Representatives until after the deadline to submit the results
17 of the stress test of the system to the General Assembly under
18 section 8510(a) (relating to stress test of system), which is
19 conducted and completed by the board after the annual actuarial
20 valuation required by section 8502(j) (relating to

1 administrative duties of board) for the fiscal year in which the
2 bill is introduced.

3 Section 2. Title 71 is amended by adding a section to read:
4 § 5910. Bills implementing supplemental annuities.

5 A bill implementing a supplemental annuity under this part
6 may not be given second consideration by the Senate or House of
7 Representatives until after the deadline to submit the results
8 of the stress test of the system to the General Assembly under
9 section 5909(a) (relating to stress test of system), which is
10 conducted and completed by the board after the annual actuarial
11 valuation required by section 5902(j) (relating to
12 administrative duties of the board) for the calendar year in
13 which the bill is introduced.

14 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
