AN ACT

- Designating the bridge carrying State Route 1025 over U.S. Route 11/15 in East Pennsboro Township, Cumberland County, as the Senator Hal Mowery Memorial Bridge.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Senator Hal Mowery Memorial Bridge.
- 7 (a) Findings. -- The General Assembly finds and declares as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (1) Harold F. Mowery, Jr., was born January 4, 1930, in
- 10 Chambersburg and was raised in Mechanicsburg.
- 11 (2) As a graduate of Mechanicsburg High School and
- 12 Dickinson College, Mr. Mowery was a product of the
- 13 Pennsylvania education system.
- 14 (3) Mr. Mowery entered the insurance business in 1954
- and earned a chartered life underwriter degree. Over several
- decades, Mr. Mowery founded multiple highly successful
- insurance businesses that employed hundreds of

1 Pennsylvanians.

- Mr. Mowery was elected to the House of Representatives in 1976 and went on to serve seven terms. In 3
- the House of Representatives, Mr. Mowery achieved a 4
- 5 reputation for expertise on fiscal and pension issues and
- 6 advocated for the application of private-sector business
- 7 principles to the operation of public programs and State
- 8 spending. He was also instrumental in establishing the Public
- 9 Employee Retirement Commission.
- 10 In 1992, Mr. Mowery was elected to represent the 31st District in the Senate of Pennsylvania. He served with 11
- distinction until his retirement in 2004. 12
- 13 During his time in the Senate, Senator Mowery
- 14 enriched the lives of thousands as Chairperson of the former
- 15 Public Health and Welfare Committee and Vice Chairperson of
- the Education Committee. He also served as Vice Chairperson 16
- 17 of the Legislative Data Processing Committee and as a rank-
- 18 and-file member of numerous standing committees, including
- 19 Banking and Insurance, Law and Justice and Labor and
- 20 Industry.
- 21 (7) During and after his public service career, Senator
- 22 Mowery was a prominent community leader. He supported the
- 23 establishment of the Camp Hill Lion Foundation to enhance
- 24 academic, athletic and cultural resources. He was also a
- 25 supporter of the Whitaker Center for Science and the Arts,
- 26 the construction of the Grace Milliman Pollock Performing
- 27 Arts Center and the performing arts, including the Harrisburg
- 28 Symphony Orchestra. Senator Mowery aided many charities by
- 29 sponsoring and supporting benefits, galas and community
- 30 fundraisers.

- 1 (8) Senator Mowery's professional achievements,
- 2 extensive community involvement and the myriad of awards and
- 3 accolades he received stand as strong testimony to his
- 4 genuine concern for the well-being of this Commonwealth and
- 5 the people of the 31st Senatorial District.
- 6 (9) By all accounts, Senator Mowery was a loving family
- 7 man, a respected businessperson and a dedicated and
- 8 accomplished public servant worthy of emulation for
- 9 generations to come.
- 10 (b) Designation. -- The bridge carrying State Route 1025 over
- 11 U.S. Route 11/15 in East Pennsboro Township, Cumberland County,
- 12 is designated as the Senator Hal Mowery Memorial Bridge.
- 13 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 14 maintain architecturally appropriate signs displaying the name
- 15 of the bridge to traffic in both directions on the bridge.
- 16 Section 2. Effective date.
- 17 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
