AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, in general provisions relating to operation of
3 vehicles, further providing for automated red light
4 enforcement systems in first class cities and for automated
5 red light enforcement systems in certain municipalities; and,
6 in rules of the road in general, further providing for
7 enforcement of failure to stop for school bus with flashing
8 red lights, for automated speed enforcement systems in active
9 work zones and for pilot program for automated speed
10 enforcement system on designated highway.

11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
12 hereby enacts as follows:

13 Section 1. Section 3116(j) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
14 Consolidated Statutes is amended and subsection (l) is amended
15 by adding a paragraph to read:

16 § 3116. Automated red light enforcement systems in first class
17 cities.

18 * * *

19 (j) Notice to owner.--

20 (1) In the case of a violation involving a motor vehicle
21 registered under the laws of this Commonwealth, the notice of

1 violation must be mailed within 30 days after the commission
2 of the violation or within 30 days after the discovery of the
3 identity of the registered owner, whichever is later, and not
4 thereafter to the address of the registered owner as listed
5 in the records of the department. In the case of motor
6 vehicles registered in jurisdictions other than this
7 Commonwealth, the notice of violation must be mailed within
8 30 days after the discovery of the identity of the registered
9 owner, and not thereafter to the address of the registered
10 owner as listed in the records of the official in the
11 jurisdiction having charge of the registration of the
12 vehicle. A notice of violation under this section must be
13 provided to an owner within 90 days of the commission of the
14 offense.

15 (2) The notice of violation shall include the option for
16 the owner to pay the fine under subsection (1) through a
17 payment plan.

19 (1) Payment of fine.--

21 (2.1) An owner shall be given the option to make
22 payments through a one-time installment or through a payment
23 plan developed by the system administrator. The payment plan
24 shall consist of no fewer than three monthly installments.

26 Section 2. Section 3117(k) of Title 75 is amended and
27 subsection (m) is amended by adding a paragraph to read:

28 § 3117. Automated red light enforcement systems in certain
29 municipalities.

1 (k) Notice to owner.--

2 (1) In the case of a violation involving a motor vehicle
3 registered under the laws of this Commonwealth, the notice of
4 violation must be mailed within 30 days after the commission
5 of the violation or within 30 days after the discovery of the
6 identity of the registered owner, whichever is later, to the
7 address of the registered owner as listed in the records of
8 the department. In the case of motor vehicles registered in
9 jurisdictions other than this Commonwealth, the notice of
10 violation must be mailed within 30 days after the discovery
11 of the identity of the registered owner to the address of the
12 registered owner as listed in the records of the official in
13 the jurisdiction having charge of the registration of the
14 vehicle. A notice of violation under this section must be
15 provided to an owner within 90 days of the commission of the
16 offense.

17 (2) The notice of violation shall include the option for
18 the owner to pay the fine under subsection (m) through a
19 payment plan.

21 (m) Payment of fine.--

22 * * *

23 (2.2) An owner shall be given the option to make
24 payments through a one-time installment or through a payment
25 plan developed by the system administrator. The payment plan
26 shall consist of no fewer than three monthly installments.

28 Section 3. Section 3345.1(i.1)(1) and (2) of Title 75 are
29 amended by adding subparagraphs to read:

30 § 3345.1. Enforcement of failure to stop for school bus with

1 flashing red lights.

3 (i.1) Notice of violation, fines and contest.--The following
4 shall apply:

5 (1) The following shall apply to notice of violation:

6 * * *

7 (v) The notice of violation shall include the option
8 for the owner to pay the fine under paragraph (2) through
9 a payment plan.

10 (2) The following shall apply to payment of a fine:

11 * * *

12 (iv) An owner shall be given the option to make
13 payments through a one-time installment or through a
14 payment plan developed by the system administrator. The
15 payment plan shall consist of no fewer than three monthly
16 installments.

18 Section 4. Section 3369(d) (2) and (3) of Title 75 are
19 amended and subsection (i) is amended by adding a paragraph to
20 read:

21 § 3369. Automated speed enforcement systems in active work
22 zones.

24 (d) Notice of violation.--

25 * * *

26 (2) In the case of a violation involving a motor vehicle
27 registered under the laws of this Commonwealth, the notice of
28 violation shall be mailed within 30 days after the commission
29 of the violation or within 30 days after the discovery of the
30 identity of the registered owner, whichever is later, to the

1 address of the registered owner as listed in the records of
2 the department. The notice of violation shall include the
3 option for the owner to pay the fine under subsection (i)
4 through a payment plan.

5 (3) In the case of a violation involving a motor vehicle
6 registered in a jurisdiction other than this Commonwealth,
7 the notice of violation shall be mailed within 30 days after
8 the discovery of the identity of the registered owner to the
9 address of the registered owner as listed in the records of
10 the official in the jurisdiction having charge of the
11 registration of the vehicle. The notice of violation shall
12 include the option for the owner to pay the fine under
13 subsection (i) through a payment plan.

17 (2.1) An owner shall be given the option to make
18 payments through a one-time installment or through a payment
19 plan developed by the system administrator. The payment plan

22 Section 5. Section 3370(k) of Title 75 is amended and
23 subsection (m) is amended by adding a paragraph to read:

24 § 3370. Pilot program for automated speed enforcement system on
25 designated highway.

27 (k) Notice to owner.--

28 (1) In the case of a violation involving a motor vehicle
29 registered under the laws of this Commonwealth, the notice of
30 violation must be mailed within 30 days after the commission

1 of the violation or within 30 days after the discovery of the
2 identity of the registered owner, whichever is later, and not
3 thereafter to the address of the registered owner as listed
4 in the records of the department. In the case of motor
5 vehicles registered in jurisdictions other than this
6 Commonwealth, the notice of violation must be mailed within
7 30 days after the discovery of the identity of the registered
8 owner to the address of the registered owner as listed in the
9 records of the official in the jurisdiction having charge of
10 the registration of the vehicle. A notice of violation under
11 this section must be provided to an owner within 90 days of
12 the commission of the offense.

24 Section 6. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
