## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto," in terms and courses of study, 5 providing for mindfulness techniques. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known 9 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a 10 11 section to read: 12 Section 1516.2. Mindfulness Techniques. -- (a) Each school 13 entity shall adopt a policy for providing classroom instruction 14 to students in kindergarten through grade twelve in techniques 15 of mindfulness for a minimum of fifteen minutes each school day. 16 (b) The mindfulness techniques required by subsection (a) 17 are not intended to be and shall not be conducted as a religious 18 service or exercise. (c) The Department of Education shall: 19

(1) Develop and distribute to school entities a model policy

- 1 on the teaching of mindfulness, which shall be consistent with
- 2 subsection (a).
- 3 (2) Develop a model mindfulness curriculum and make the
- 4 <u>curriculum available to all school entities and, upon request,</u>
- 5 to nonpublic schools.
- 6 (3) Develop and post on its publicly accessible Internet
- 7 <u>website materials and guidelines on current best practice</u>
- 8 <u>techniques in the teaching of mindfulness as required under</u>
- 9 <u>subsection (a).</u>
- 10 (d) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 11 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 12 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 13 "Mindfulness" shall mean the practice of being aware of one's
- 14 body, mind and feelings in the present moment.
- 15 "Nonpublic school" shall mean a nonprofit school, other than
- 16 <u>a school entity</u>, wherein a resident of this Commonwealth may
- 17 legally fulfill the compulsory school attendance requirements of
- 18 this act.
- 19 "School entity" shall mean a school district, joint school
- 20 district, charter school, regional charter school, cyber charter
- 21 school, intermediate unit or area career and technical school.
- 22 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
