AN ACT

1 Amending Title 74 (Transportation) of the Pennsylvania  
2 Consolidated Statutes, in turnpike, further providing for  
3 commission powers and duties.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 8107 of Title 74 of the Pennsylvania  
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:  
8 § 8107. Commission powers and duties.

10 (c) Toll collectors.--

11 (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the  
12 commission shall employ individuals as toll collectors at  
13 each facility designed for the collection of cash payment of  
14 tolls on the turnpike. Toll collectors shall be available to  
15 collect payment at each tolling facility during peak hours as  
16 described under paragraph (2).

17 (2) The following apply to peak hours:

18 (i) Peak hours shall be determined by the

1 commission.

2 (ii) Peak hours shall be the hours that the  
3 commission determines that the highest volume of vehicles  
4 passes through a tolling facility.

5 (iii) Peak hours shall be no fewer than 12  
6 consecutive hours in a 24-hour period.

7 (iv) Peak hours may be different among tolling  
8 facilities.

9 (v) Outside of peak hours, a toll may be collected  
10 by electronic toll collection and a violation enforcement  
11 system.

12 (3) As used in this subsection, the term "toll  
13 collector" means an individual who is employed at the  
14 commission's discretion and is responsible for collecting  
15 prescribed tolls from a driver who passes through a tolling  
16 facility.

17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
