Depositing waste and other material on highway, 10 property or waters. 11 12 (d) Penalty. -- Any person violating any of the provisions of subsection (a) or (b) commits a summary offense and shall, upon 1.3 14 conviction, be sentenced to either or both of the following: 15 To pay a fine of not more than: 16 [\$900] \$1,100 for a violation which occurs in an (i) easement purchased under the program established by 17 section 14.1 of the act of June 30, 1981 (P.L.128, 18

No.43), known as the Agricultural Area Security Law;

2 (ii) [\$600] \$800 for a violation which occurs in an

3 agricultural security area as defined in section 3 of the

4 Agricultural Area Security Law; or

- 8 (e) Disposition of fines, etc.--Revenue from the collection
- 9 of fines and bail forfeitures in the course of enforcement of

- 12 (2) One-half shall be allocated to the department for

- 14 litter control and recycling and awareness of the provisions

- 19 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
