AN ACT

1 Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled
 2 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the
 3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the
 4 Executive Department thereof and the administrative
 5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof,
 6 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or
 7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or
 8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative
 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and
 10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative
 11 officers, and of the several administrative departments,
 12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the
 13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive
 14 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of
 15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and
 16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards,
 17 and commissions; providing for judicial administration; and
 18 prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation
 19 of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of
 20 certain departments, boards and commissions shall be
 21 determined," in powers and duties of the Department of
 22 Revenue, repealing provisions relating to vehicle and tractor
 23 codes.

24 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
 25 hereby enacts as follows:

26 Section 1. Section 2502 of the act of April 9, 1929
 27 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, is
 28 repealed:

1 [Section 2502. Vehicle and Tractor Codes.--In the collection
2 of motor license fees, fees for titling vehicles and tractors
3 and operators' license fees, and the issuance of certificates of
4 title and motor and operators' licenses, the Department of
5 Revenue shall be entitled to such assistance from the
6 Pennsylvania State Police as the department may deem necessary.
7 The Secretary of Revenue may designate the person in charge
8 of the work to which this section refers as the Commissioner of
9 Motor Vehicles.]

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
