## AN ACT

- Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), entitled "An act concerning townships of the second class; and amending,
- revising, consolidating and changing the law relating
- 4 thereto," in township police, further providing for creating
- or disbanding police force.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 1901 of the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103,
- 9 No.69), known as The Second Class Township Code, is amended to
- 10 read:
- 11 Section 1901. Creating or Disbanding Police Force. -- (a) The
- 12 board of supervisors may by resolution create or disband a
- 13 police force within the township or, upon the petition of not
- 14 less than twenty-five registered electors or taxpayers of the
- 15 township, appoint police officers. Any police force created by
- 16 the board of supervisors must operate as a full-time police
- 17 <u>department.</u>
- 18 (b) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 19 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless

- 1 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 2 <u>"Full-time police department." A police force that maintains</u>
- 3 <u>twenty-four-hour-per-day police coverage in its designated area.</u>
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
