AN ACT

- 1 Requiring institutions of higher education to provide students
- with education loan disclosures; and conferring powers and
- imposing duties on the Department of Education.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Definitions.
- 7 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 8 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 9 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 10 "Education loan." A direct loan or loan insured or
- 11 guaranteed under a Federal or State program or a program of
- 12 private insurance that is made to assist a student in obtaining
- 13 a degree from an institution of higher education.
- "Institution of higher education." An approved or eligible
- 15 institution of higher education under the act of August 7, 1963
- 16 (P.L.549, No.290), referred to as the Pennsylvania Higher
- 17 Education Assistance Agency Act.
- 18 Section 2. Education loan disclosure.

- 1 (a) Disclosure requirements. -- An institution of higher
- 2 education that receives education loan information for a student
- 3 enrolled in the institution of higher education shall provide
- 4 the following information to the student:

- 5 (1) An estimate of the total amount of education loans 6 taken out by the student.
- 7 (2) An estimate, which may include a statement that the 8 estimates and ranges provided are general in nature and not 9 meant as a guarantee or promise of the actual projected
- 11 (i) The potential total payoff amount of the
 12 education loans incurred or a range of the total payoff
 13 amount.
- (ii) Monthly repayment amounts that a similarly
 situated borrower may incur, including principal and
 interest, for the amount of loans the student has taken
 out at the time the information is provided.
- 18 (b) Time.--An institution of higher education shall provide 19 the information required under this section annually beginning 20 in 2017.
- 21 (c) Method.--An institution of higher education shall 22 provide the disclosure to students through first class mail or 23 electronic mail.
- 24 (d) Administration.—The Department of Education shall 25 administer and enforce the provisions of this act.
- 26 (e) Nonliability. -- An institution of higher education shall
- 27 not incur liability for any representations made under this
- 28 section.

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- 29 Section 3. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect in 60 days.
